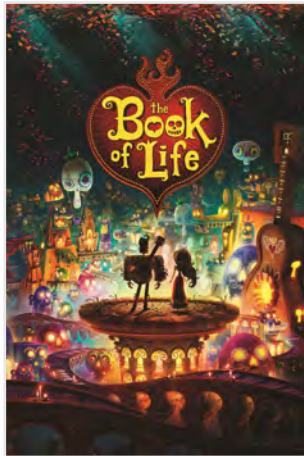
**The Lego Ninjago Movie**

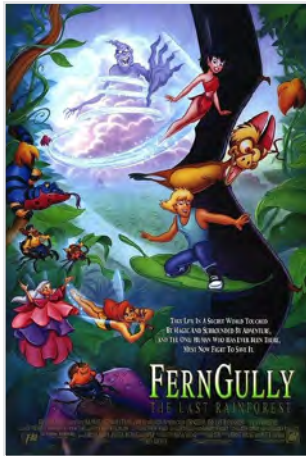

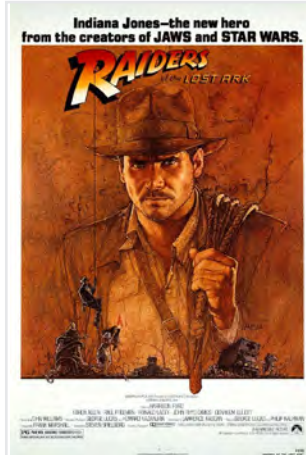

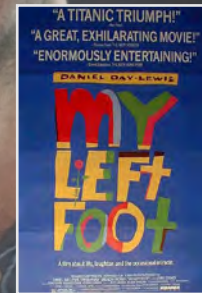
